HESI A₂

A minimum score of 80 or higher on each of the five required sections and the Personality Profile and Learning Style results must be achieved prior to submitting the application.

HESI A₂ scores are considered in the point's award ranking process. Scores on the math and anatomy/physiology sections are considered separately. Scores on the Reading Comprehension, Grammar, and Vocabulary/General Knowledge are combined and the average score is considered for points.

In addition to Methodist's ranking system, ECC also uses a point system to rank applicants.

You must take all the courses listed above before making application to the El Centro College Nursing Program at Methodist Health System.
