ADMISSION REQUIREMENTS

- Complete online application and submit application fee
- Submit official, sealed transcripts, sent from the granting institution(s), from all universities attended
- 2.5 GPA or higher on prerequisite courses
- Test of English as a Foreign Language (TOEFL) may apply if applicant's native/first language is not English or applicant does not hold a bachelor's or higher degree from an accredited U.S. institution, even if the student has met one of the stated University exemptions for the TOEFL
- International students with an F1 or J1 visa are not eligible to take online courses, but may apply to the on-campus program
