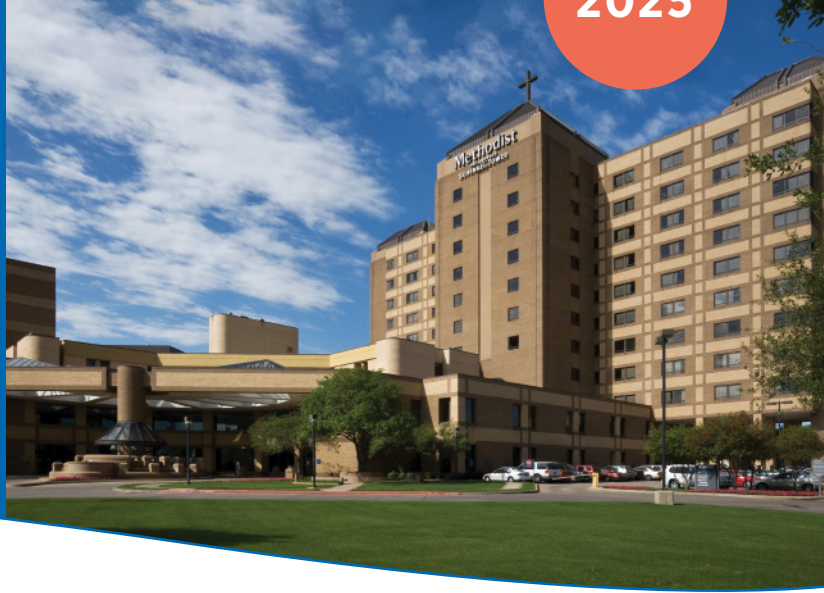

LABOR AND DELIVERY FLOOR DEBUTS AFTER 9-MONTH MAKEOVER

A newly redesigned labor and delivery unit returned to welcoming the gift of life at Methodist Dallas Medical Center — just in time for the holidays.

Members of the community toured the transformed space in early December with donors and Methodist Health System leaders after a ribbon-cutting at the hospital. The Women's and Children's Services unit includes 14 labor and delivery suites, two operating rooms for cesarean sections, and a recovery area.

"Members of our medical staff worked hand in hand with hospital designers to create a labor and delivery space that is as functional as it is beautiful," Methodist Dallas President **John Phillips**, FACHE, said at Wednesday's ribbon cutting.

After nine months of construction, patients moved into the unit, which also features a five-room obstetrics (OB) emergency department to provide around-the-clock, specialized care for expecting mothers led by OB hospitalists.

"By adding an OB emergency department, we are once again elevating our care for mothers and their growing families," Phillips said.



WEIGHT MANAGEMENT TEAM LAUNCHES MEDICAL WEIGHT LOSS PROGRAM

Methodist Dallas now offers a multidisciplinary and evidence-based lifestyle intervention for patients who are looking to achieve their health goals: the Methodist Dallas Weight Loss & Wellness Program.

The program includes physician monitoring, weight loss medication assistance, one-on-one nutrition, and fitness counseling, peer support opportunities, and much more. The program is available in three, six, and 12-month stretches.

"This is a partnership focused on sustainable, long-term health and happiness," said **Gabriela Arias**, MD, physician on the medical staff at Methodist Dallas. "We are committed to providing support and resources that patients need to succeed."

EMERGENCY STAFF EARNS NATIONAL AWARD

The emergency department at Methodist Dallas is among 94 nationwide to receive the Lantern Award, an accolade granted once every three years by the Emergency Nurses Association.

This designation is a testament to their staff's commitment to quality, safety, a healthy work environment, and innovation in nursing practice and emergency care.

"This national recognition illustrates how well our robust emergency care team handles our most critical patients," said Methodist Dallas President **John Phillips**, FACHE. "Our Level I Trauma Center is not only focused on quality, but also compassion for every patient, visitor, and staff member."

Each hospital completes an application showcasing leadership, education, advocacy, and research.



FIRST CLASS OF PARAMEDICS GRADUATES FROM JOINT PROGRAM WITH UT DALLAS

The first class of paramedics graduated from an educational collaboration between Methodist Health System and The University of Texas at Dallas.

The North Texas Paramedic Education Consortium began enrolling its first students early last year, supplementing the university's existing EMT training program and helping educate future paramedics. Some of the students are from local and regional fire departments. Methodist Dallas President **John Phillips**, FACHE, sits on the consortium's board of directors.

"This program is yet another example of how Methodist is committed to growing our own and sharing our resources to expand the community of healthcare," said **Robert Simonson**, DO, chair of emergency medicine at Methodist Dallas and the consortium's medical director.

METHODIST MARKS 40 YEARS OF SERVING TRANSPLANT PATIENTS FROM PUERTO RICO

In fall 2023, Methodist Dallas celebrated the 40th anniversary of Methodist Dallas Medical Center's first kidney transplant to a patient from Puerto Rico. Since 1983, the hospital has performed nearly 600 kidney transplants on Puerto Rican patients who have come through the Transplant Institute Methodist Dallas – San Juan location. This truly remarkable achievement has changed the lives of thousands and continues to make a substantial impact on the transplant needs in Puerto Rico.

FAITH COMMUNITY NURSING

Through local churches, Methodist Health System provides education and health outreach, including flu shots and biometric screenings.

METHODIST GENERATIONS

This program offers a variety of wellness activities, social events, and educational outreach for people ages 55 and older.

MOBILE MAMMOGRAPHY

Methodist's mobile mammography unit brought breast cancer screenings directly to 68,000 women since 2000.

METHODIST ALLIANCE FOR PATIENTS AND PHYSICIANS (MAP2)

This accountable care organization improves and saves lives through coordinated care for more than 70,000 people. These patients have seen overall improvement in health measures,

as well as a lowered overall cost of care. For these efforts, MAP2 has achieved national recognition for the quality of care given to patients.

LIFE SHINES BRIGHT PREGNANCY PROGRAM

This program is dedicated to helping women have healthy pregnancies with the CenteringPregnancy® model of care. Since it started in 2008, the program has lowered the preterm birth rate among its participants to only 5.4%.

MEDASSIST

This program provides vital bridge medications — 360 prescriptions in the past year — to patients in financial need. Through pharmaceutical partnerships, MedAssist also connected patients to 265 prescriptions for free medications valued at \$60,856.

School leaders say the donations are invaluable, helping children and teachers as they kick off a new semester. Any remaining items go to the school's supply closet, which teachers and families can access year-round.

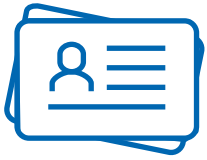


REDESIGNATION AS MAGNET HOSPITAL CELEBRATED IN NEW ORLEANS
