FIFTH-FLOOR PROJECT EXPANDS INPATIENT ACCESS

Methodist Midlothian Medical Center has added 30 inpatient beds to the hospital, which features Intermediate Care Suites and office space. This expansion is part of the health systems' long-range plans to meet the healthcare needs of the increasing population in Ellis County.

The Intermediate Care Unit, located on the fifth floor in previously unused space, provides residents with further access to award-winning care. This addition allows patients to stay in the community for a wide range of healthcare needs.

COLLABORATION PROVIDES HEALTH SCIENCE STUDENTS WITH HANDS-ON LEARNING

Methodist Midlothian collaborates with the Midlothian ISD to introduce health science students to the healthcare industry and expose them to future career pathways.

These efforts allow students to shadow hospital workers throughout the school year and include a large event in the spring called the "MISD Medical Symposium." During the symposium, high school juniors and seniors learn hands-on training to suture wounds, read EKG and heart rhythms, place a breathing tube, insert an IV using ultrasound guidance, practice paramedic skills, and learn how to use a da Vinci surgical robot. Additionally, they are able ask questions about nursing and medical school with the various presenters.

PINK OUT GAME RAISES \$10,000 FOR WOMEN'S IMAGING SERVICES

The Midlothian High School Student Council partnered with Methodist Midlothian and sold pink T-shirts and raised \$10,000 to support Women's Imaging Services.
