Implementation Strategy Purpose



Implementation Strategy Development

Methodist Health System first opened its doors in 1927 as a single, 100-bed facility called Dallas Methodist Hospital. It has since become one of the leading healthcare providers in North Texas, owning and operating multiple individually licensed hospitals that serve the residents across the state. Methodist Mansfield Medical Center and Methodist Southlake Medical Center serve the community of Tarrant County. Facilities with overlapping counties of patient origin collaborated to provide a joint CHNA report in accordance with the U.S. Treasury regulations and 501(r)(3) of the Internal Revenue Code.


